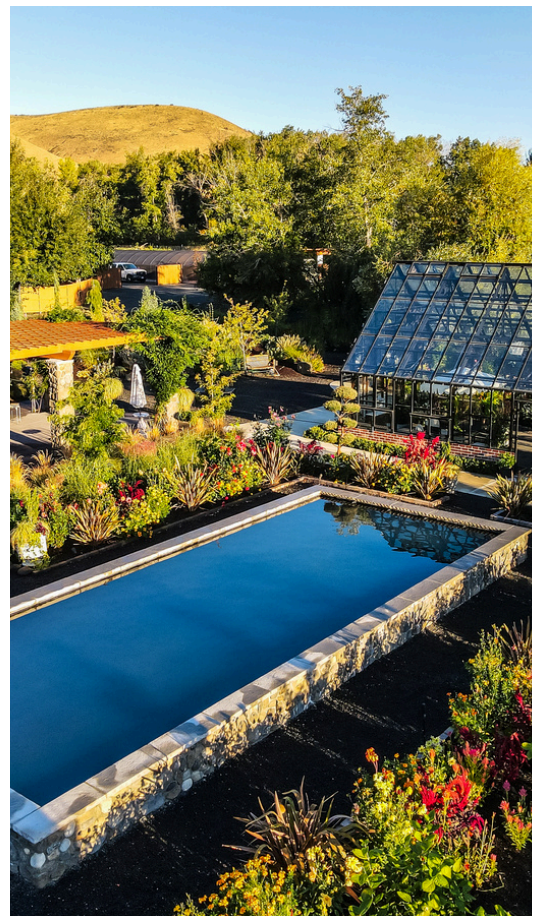
About THE VENUE

EVENT TENT

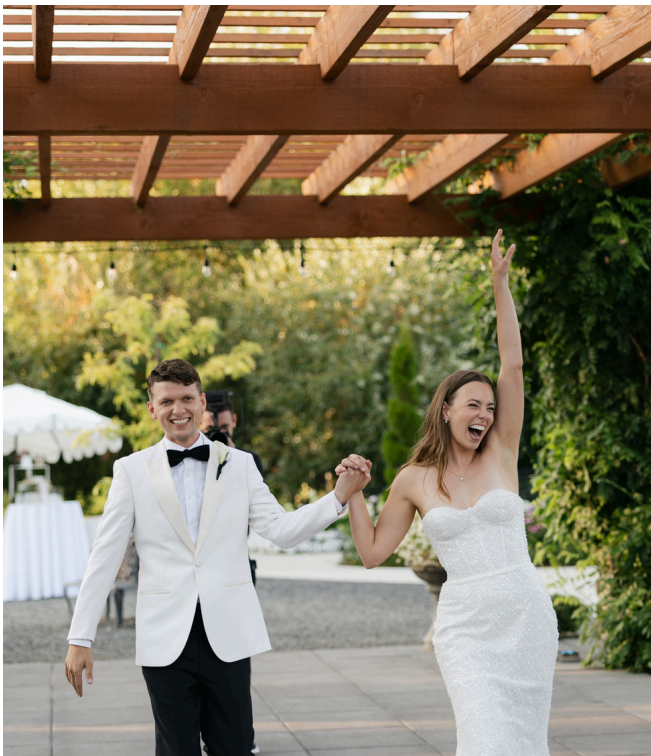
Our Event Tent offers a spacious, elegant setting for outdoor weddings while keeping guests comfortable and protected from the elements.

Our wedding pergola is a multipurpose outdoor space. It features six stone columns crafted by mason Juan Gonzalez, beams and rafters from rough-sawn northwest timber, and a stone floor.

The Pergola can comfortably seat 60 for dinner and is a popular dance floor location.

THE BRICK HOUSE

Built in 1911, the Brick House stands as the historic centerpiece of our property and the inspiration for our name. Originally part of the Diamond Ring Guest Ranch, the home has lived many lives—from early homestead to lively gathering place. Its history includes local characters like Frida Olds, who hosted informal rodeos and ranch events long before weddings graced the grounds.

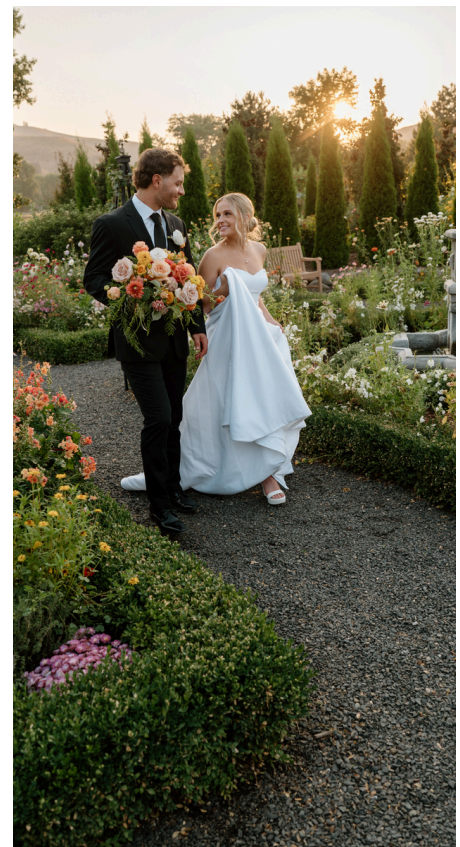


THE POTAGER

Our French-inspired Potager intermingles vegetables, fruits, flowers, and herbs. It emphasizes symmetry, order, geometric shapes, and organized color palettes.

It features four unique obelisk structures around a centrally located French Country Fountain. This area of the garden is often featured during a cocktail hour with live music.

During the early summer months, the greenery and geometry shine, while in later months, the flowers become a tall and wild mix softening the edges.

THE JAPANESE GARDENS

Our Japanese-inspired Garden utilizes the elements of stone, water, and plants. It draws on the principles of enclosure and balance to create a serene and calm space.

The Japanese concept of the “Maura Circle,” alluding to strength, the circle of life, connection, letting go of expectations, and the beauty in imperfection, is represented in the pathway that encases the lawn, the circular deck married to the water, and the island in the koi pond.



GARDEN *Features*

GARDEN GRACES

The Graces are a pair of enchanting sculptures created by artist Austin J. Smith. The Graces embrace traditional form and sculpture. The duo is framed by our allée de jardin, a French-inspired garden alley.



STONE REFLECTION POOL

Our gardens feature a hand laid stone reflection pool made with rock from our property and crafted by mason Juan Gonzalez. The shallow pool perfectly reflects the crest of the Manastash Ridge and captures pieces of the sky line in the gardens.

Guest CABINS

Our six newly renovated cabins offer a private and luxurious retreat for couples, families, and wedding guests.

Every cabin boasts a breathtaking view of the Manastash Ridge and Canyon, creating a serene backdrop. Surrounded by more than 30 acres of lush pastureland—with grazing horses and cattle just beyond the fence line—the cabins provide a sense of stillness.

Thoughtfully designed with comfort in mind, each cabin features full kitchens, king-size beds, plush furnishings, and both indoor and outdoor fireplaces for year-round coziness. Floral Policy

To protect the health of our extensive gardens and greenhouse collections, all floral designs used at Brick House must be provided by The Flower Shoppe. Outside florists and outside flowers are not permitted on the property. This policy helps ensure all plant materials are properly vetted and meet our pest-management standards, protecting the gardens that make Brick House such a special place to celebrate.

THE VENUE *Rules*

01 Booking & Payments – All reservations require a signed contract and a non-refundable deposit. Full payment must be made by the agreed deadline.

02 Capacity Limits – The number of guests must not exceed the venue's maximum capacity to ensure safety and compliance with regulations.

03 Alcohol & Beverages – Alcohol is only permitted with the necessary permits and must be served responsibly by licensed bartenders to guests of legal drinking age. Unauthorized distribution or sale is prohibited.

04 Smoking Policy – Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not allowed inside the venue or within 20 feet of any entrance. A designated smoking area is available outside.

05 Decorations & Setup – All decorations must be approved in advance. Open flames, confetti, and adhesives that may damage surfaces are not allowed. The venue must be returned to its original condition after the event.

06 Liability & Damages – The event host is responsible for any damages caused by guests, vendors, or attendees. A security deposit may be required for potential damages or excessive cleanup.

FAQ's

Q: What are we responsible for in terms of set up and take down?

A: The Brick House will set up tables, chairs, bar tables, flowers (as agreed), and the event tent, stock the restroom building, provide trash cans, liners, and a trash/recycle trailer. We will rerack tables and chairs the following morning.

Q: Can the cabins be rented for an extra night

A: With the Iris Package the cabins can be rented for additional nights before the events. Sunday night is reserved for Willow Weddings who can rent the cabins for additional nights after the event.

Q: How does the credit to The Flower Shoppe work?

A: After your floral design consult, Aubrey will generate a quote based off of your floral design requests. An automatic credit will be applied to that amount (package dependent) and the remaining amount will be invoiced directly.

Q: Do we need event insurance?

A: Yes, insurance is required. the exact coverage is listed in the contract. Typically event insurance can be added through your home or auto policy. If your insurance doesn't offer this, Progressive offers stand-alone event insurance through their website. For our requirements, it typically costs \$80-\$150 for the coverage.

Q: What if it rains?

A: In addition to our Glass Greenhouse (seated capacity of 50), we now have our new event tent which can accommodate a wedding reception including a seated dinner of up to 150 people. The tent is located over at our Japanese gardens.

FAQ's

Q: Can guests Uber/Ride Share?

A: There are not typically many ride shares available in Ellensburg. There are multiple taxi companies as well as shuttle companies the can assist with guest transportation.

Q: Do you require specific vendors?

A: No, we allow you to bring in any vendor that you choose with the exception of our Flower Shoppe. We also don't have any preferred vendors at this time. However, we do have a vendor guide to help you in your planning and we are always happy to share our experience of vendors we have worked with in the past.

Q: How can we hold a date?

A: A 50% deposit and signed contract is required to hold a date.

Q: How many guests do the cabins hold?

A: Four of our cabins hold 4 guests and two of our cabins hold 2 guests for a max of 20 people.

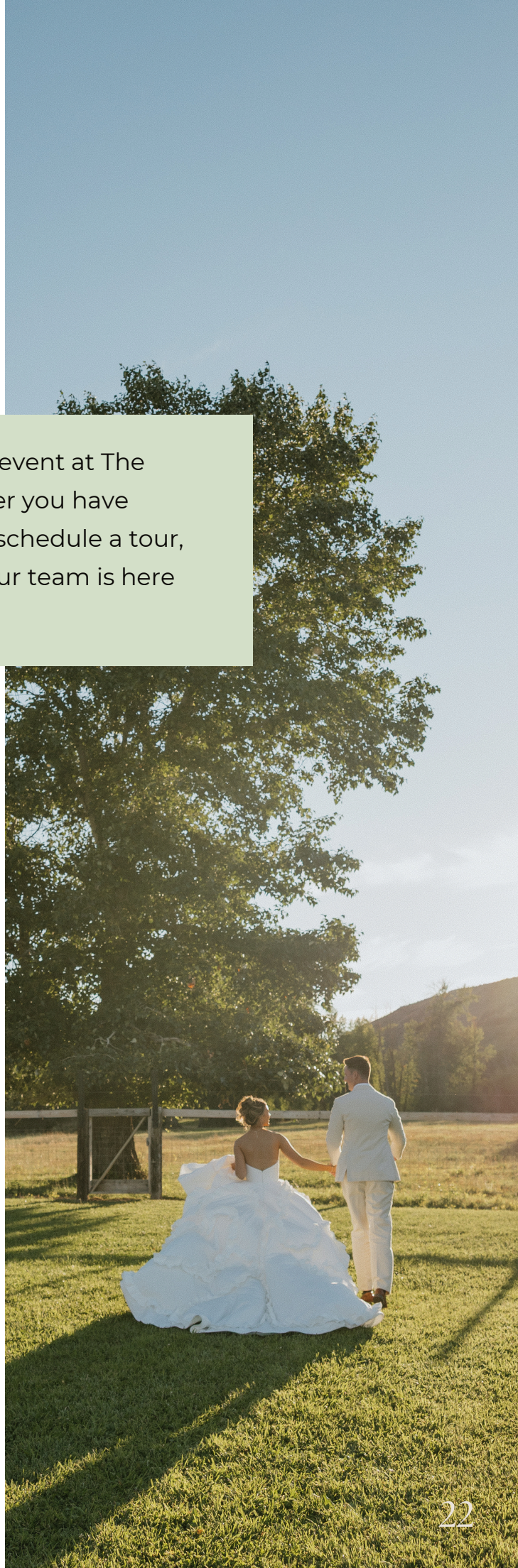
